**St. Helen Building Project: Update**

(1) The Building Committee met this week with Fr. Ben; we discussed the floor plan and costs of the project. An updated floor plan will be prepared, then:

(2) The Architect will work on the construction documents that will be submitted to the state, for plan review.

(3) Capital Campaign Update: **Goal:** \$330,000 **Actual:** \$150,279.63

**Our Lady of the Caves Rebuilding Project**

(1) Bids for building the new church came in significantly higher than we expected. Fr. Ben is talking to the Archdiocese about additional funding options, and we are also looking to find pews, stations, statues, etc. from churches that have closed, to save money on the project.

(2) Construction is delayed while we look into further funding for the church.

(3) In the meantime, sewer lines are being moved, and we will continue with the removal of the old concrete pad before long.
